In accordance with the Constitution of the National Rural Letter Carriers' Association Article IX, Section 7, this



notice hereby constitutes written notification to all NRLCA members that an election shall be held for the position of a Local Steward in their office. Failure of members to exercise this right will result in the local office being assigned representation in accordance with the Constitution of the National Rural Letter Carriers' Association.

The selection of a Local Steward should be in accordance with democratic procedures. To become a steward, a rural carrier must be a member of the National Rural Letter Carriers' Association. Local Steward Elections will be conducted in the month of July of every fourth year (i.e.; 2016, 2020, 2024 etc.) unless the incumbent Local Steward is unopposed. The Steward shall serve until a successor is elected and certified or until he or she resigns. An election may

be called any time the position is vacant, or when two-thirds of the members submit a petition to the District Representative for approval a Local Steward may be re-elected to the position. Written notification to all NRLCA members shall be given at least 15 days before the date of the election. A majority vote of those NRLCA members voting is required for an election. When there is more than one (1) Local Steward at an installation, including stations and/or branches, a Chief Steward will be elected by the NRLCA members of said office.
