On several occasions, the most recent being July 16, 2015, the parties discussed the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance concerns the delivery of ordinary parcels by rural carriers beyond one-half mile.

During our discussion, we mutually agree that the following will constitute full and complete settlement of this grievance.

Handbook PO-603, *Rural Carrier Duties and Responsibilities*, section 331.21 states in part "you must deliver parcels to any residence or business that is on the line of travel, or within one-half mile of the route and has a passable road leading to it."

The parties agree these provisions limit the distance rural carriers are required to deviate in order to deliver ordinary parcels.
