Pursuant to Article 15, Section (D), of the parties' National Agreement, the Association submits this National-Level Grievance.

In dispute is the Postal Services action to circumvent mail, specifically parcels, in the 6 to 9 Play program. This action is in violation of, but not limited to, Article 5 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement, and the *Final Determination, Rural Route Evaluated Compensation System* (*RRECS*), *Submitted to USPS and NLRCA by: Dr. Louis Martin-Vega, Chairperson, Dean of the College of Engineering, North Carolina State University, May 31, 2018.* 

Parcels are being diverted from the rural routes prior to determining if an additional trip would be required to ensure that a specified percentage of parcels are being delivered prior to 9am. Specifically, these parcels are being delivered on static "W" routes, and dynamic "L" routes.
