Dear Mr. Johnson:

On November 1 the parties discussed the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance concerns a rural carrier being required to case Delivery Point Sequence (DPS) letter mail.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agree that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case.

When rural carriers are required to case DPS letter mail appropriate compensation will be provided in accordance with Handbook PO-603, Section 541.41.

Accordingly, we agree to remand this grievance to the parties at Step 2 for application and for further processing and arbitration, if necessary.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
