6 Feet	Examiners will remain at least 6 ft. away from the carrier at all times in the office, including during: DPS / FSS retrieval Vehicle load & unload Retrieving and returning empty equipment	 Comply with social distancing at all times Examiner and carrier will wear face coverings in accordance with local ordinances, CDC recommendations, and when social distancing cannot be maintained Practice good respiratory etiquette and hygiene
	Examiners will remain at least 6 ft. away from the carrier at all times on the street, this includes: Mail delivery Reloading Accountable delivery Package delivery CPMS scan & collection Lunch / breaks	 Observations and notes are made from a 6 ft. distance Examiner and carrier will wear face coverings in accordance with local ordinances, CDC recommendations, and when social distancing cannot be maintained
